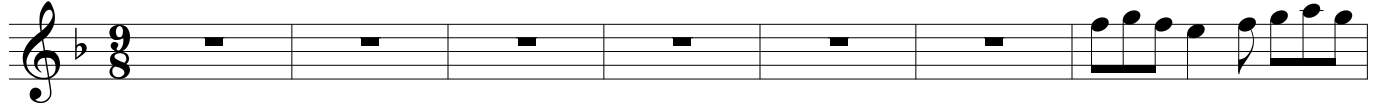

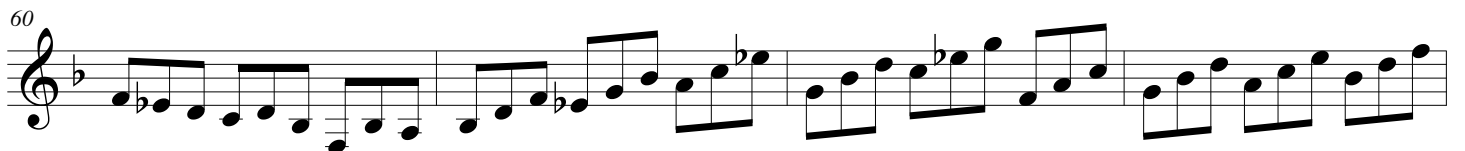
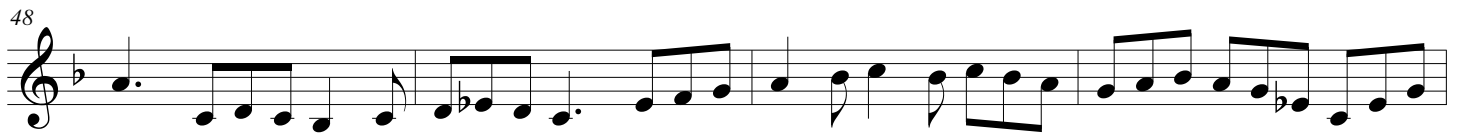
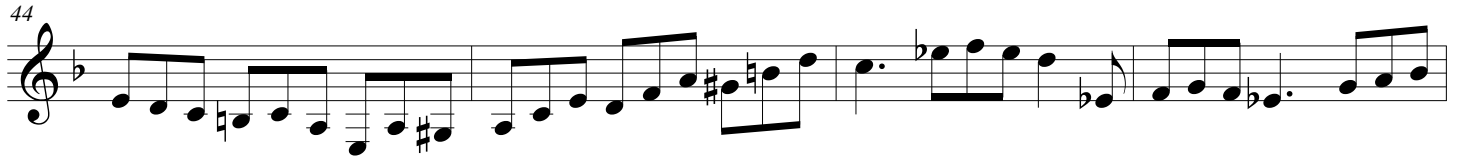

Invention in F major
